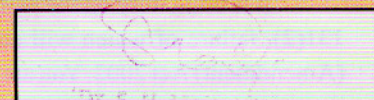

It is obligatory on the part of the patentee to supply information under Section 146 (2) read with Rules 131(1) & 131(2), failure of which will attract the penalty provisions under the Patents Act, 1970 as amended by the Patents (Amendment) Act 2002. You are, therefore requested to file the said information within the Prescribed time every year.
