If the renewal fee is not paid within the prescribed time, and extension of time upto 6 months can be obtained on payment of an additional fee of Rs. 250/- for individual(s) and Rs. 1,000/- for legal entity other than individual(s) per month.

Application for extension of time should be made on Form 4.

Deeds of assignments of patents and other documents affecting the proprietorship of patents such as licences, mortgages, etc. should be entered in the Register of Patents as otherwise the rights of interests created by such documents may not be recognised.

It is obligatory on the part of the patentee to supply information under Section 146 (2) read with Rules 131(1) & 131(2), failure of which will attract the penalty provisions under the Patents Act, 1970 as amended by the Patents (Amendment) Act 2002. You are, therefore requested to file the said information within the Prescribed time every year.
